What are the Team Events?

Event 1 - Safety Quiz

Safety Quiz is a multiple choice test for evaluation of a team's knowledge regarding defensive driving and winter maintenance operations.

Event 2 - Pre-Trip Inspection

Inspection of the snow removal vehicles as taught/required under CDL testing. Team members may communicate and discuss items during the 15 minute inspection, however, only one member is allowed to speak to the judge.

Event 3 - Front Plow Mounting

Intended to evaluate a team's skill, teamwork and safety awareness in aligning and hitching the front plow correctly to a 3/4 ton truck's plow frame. Seven minutes are provided to complete the hitch.

Event 4 - Backing with Compressor

Intended to evaluate a team's skill in backing a combination of vehicles trough a winding route and into a simulated parking area. Vehicle and compressor are reversed 150 feet. Spotter must be in line of sight of driver at all times and is not allowed within the course marked with cones.

Event 5 - Plow Slalom

Plow slalom is used to evaluate a team's ability to safely maneuver a plow truck without any part of the vehicle (including the plow) coming in contact with any obstacles such as traffic cones, barriers, barrels, etc.
